Honoring and recognizing Imhotep Charter men's basketball team for winning the 2017 Philadelphia Public League Championship title.

WHEREAS, On February 23, 2017 at Saint Joseph's Hagan Arena the Imhotep Charter Panthers won the men's basketball championship for the Philadelphia Public League by defeating the Martin Luther King Cougars 53-49 in overtime; and

WHEREAS, Imhotep's starting point guard Darron Russell was deemed the Most Valuable Player for the second time in his basketball career for scoring a game-high of 24 points; and

WHEREAS, With this Public League Championship Imhotep will have won its 6th Public League championship and now faces Conwell-Egan on March 4, 2017 at Philadelphia University for the all-city title and the right to go on to the state playoff game; and
