## AN ORDINANCE

Revising parking regulations on Spruce Street between South Broad Street and South 2nd Street.

*THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:*

SECTION 1. All existing parking regulations on Spruce Street between Broad Street and 2nd Street are hereby terminated.

SECTION 2. The following parking regulations are hereby established:

No Parking Any Time

Spruce Street from Broad Street to 2nd Street, South side.

2-Hour Parking  
8:00am – 10:00pm  
Monday – Saturday  
Except Parking Permit 4

Spruce Street from Broad Street to Juniper Street, excluding turning lane, North side.

2-Hour Parking  
8:00am – 4:00pm  
Monday – Saturday  
Except Parking Permit 4

3-Hour Parking  
4:00pm – 10:00pm  
Monday – Saturday  
Except Parking Permit 4

Spruce Street from Juniper Street to 13th Street, North side.

2-Hour Parking

Monday – Wednesday

Except Parking Permit 5

Spruce Street from 6th Street to 2nd Street, North side.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be effective upon the placement of parking signs after completion of the Department's next resurfacing of Spruce Street.
