# Referred to the Committee on Licenses and Inspections

#### AN ORDINANCE

Amending Title 9 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Regulation of Businesses, Trades and Professions," to restrict meter installations, including by prohibiting installations in unlicensed premises and by requiring companies performing installations to provide information to the Department of Licenses and Inspections; all under certain terms and conditions.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Title 9 of The Philadelphia Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

TITLE 9. REGULATION OF BUSINESSES, TRADES AND PROFESSIONS

#### CHAPTER 9-600. SERVICE AND OTHER BUSINESSES

\* \* \*

§ 9-637. Public Utilities - Meter Installations.

- (1) For purposes of this Section 9-637, a "public utility" means any provider to the public of gas, electric or water service.
- (2) No public utility shall install a meter at any residential premises, for purposes of monitoring usage, without first:
