AN ORDINANCE

Amending Title 14 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled “Zoning and Planning,” by amending Section 14-906, entitled “Market Street East Sign Regulations,” all under certain terms and conditions.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Title 14 of The Philadelphia Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

TITLE 14. ZONING AND PLANNING

CHAPTER 14-900. SIGNS

* * *

§ 14-906. Market Street East Sign Regulations.

(2) Applicability.

The provisions of this §14-906 (Market Street East Sign Regulations) apply to accessory and non-accessory signs not otherwise permitted by this Zoning Code and located in the Market Street East Advertising District, subject to all of the following:

* * *

(c) The sign shall be located no more than 100 ft. north or south of the lot line on Market Street, *but may be located more than 100 ft. north of the lot line on Market Street if located on the north-facing façade of a bridge structure over 9th Street or 10th Street between Market Street and Filbert Street.*
