AN ORDINANCE

Establishing parking regulations in the vicinity of: Locust street and S. 45th street; S. 46th street and Spruce street; S. 45th street and Kingsessing avenue; Wiota street and Powelton avenue; Stiles street and N. 50th Street; Springfield avenue and Farragut street; St. Marks street and Spruce street.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. The following parking regulation is hereby established:

Two Hour Parking 7:00 AM – 12:00 AM Monday – Sunday Except RPP# 2

Locust street, both sides S. 45th street to S. 46th street.

SECTION 2. The following parking regulation is hereby established:

Two Hour parking 8:00 AM – 6:30 PM Monday – Friday Except RPP #2

S. 46th street, both sides, Spruce street to Locust street.

SECTION 3. The following parking regulation is hereby established:

One Hour Parking 8:00 AM – 12:00 AM Monday – Friday Except RPP# 2

S. 45th street, west side, Kingsessing avenue to Baltimore avenue.

SECTION 4. The following parking regulation is hereby established:

Two Hour parking 8:00 AM – 8:00 PM Monday – Saturday Except RPP #2

Springfield avenue, both sides, Farragut street to 46th street.

SECTION 7. The following parking regulation is hereby established:

Two Hour parking 8:00 AM – 12:00 AM Monday – Sunday Except RPP #2

St. Marks street, both sides, Spruce street to Pine street.
