Amending Title 19 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Finance, Taxes and Collections," Chapter 19-1300, entitled "Real Estate Taxes," by adding a new Section 19-1310, entitled "Providing for a Tax Credit for Lead Paint and Other Hazards Remediation;" all under certain terms and conditions.

AN ORDINANCE

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Title 19 of The Philadelphia Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

TITLE 19. FINANCE, TAXES AND COLLECTIONS.

* * *

CHAPTER 19-1300. REAL ESTATE TAXES

* * *

§19-1310. Tax Credit for Lead Paint and Other Hazards Remediation.

- (1) Tax Credit. Any lessor who incurs the expense of remediation of lead paint and other hazards required under § 6-803 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Lead Disclosure Obligation," shall be entitled to a full credit for all such expenses against real estate taxes imposed under this Chapter for the property subjected to such remediation.
- (2) Regulations. The Revenue Department shall issue regulations governing the implementation of this Section, including the manner in which eligibility for this tax credit is determined.
