Recognizing and honoring the 80th Anniversary of the Philadelphia Youth Orchestra.

WHEREAS, The Philadelphia Youth Orchestra is a world-class ensemble-based educational institution serving gifted young musicians throughout the Delaware Valley; and

WHEREAS, The Philadelphia Youth Orchestra was founded in 1939 as a small, volunteer-based program; and

WHEREAS, Today, the Philadelphia Youth Orchestra provides several professional-caliber educational programs to nearly 600 students ranging from 6 to 21 years old; and

WHEREAS, Programs vary on skill and specialty and include: The Philadelphia Youth Orchestra, The Philadelphia Young Artists Orchestra, The Philadelphia Young Musicians Orchestra, Bravo Brass, and the Philadelphia Region Youth String Music; and

WHEREAS, Additionally, in 2010, The Philadelphia Youth Orchestra established an after school program, Tune Up Philly, which serves local students from disadvantaged economic and social circumstances; and

WHEREAS, The success of the Philadelphia Youth Orchestra can largely be attributed its strong and steady leadership; and

WHEREAS, The Philadelphia Youth Orchestra has only had five musical directors in its 80 years of operation; and

WHEREAS, The current director, Louis Scaglione, took the reigns in 1997 and continues to serve as the musical director in addition to his role as the organization's President; and

WHEREAS, The Philadelphia Youth Orchestra has produced world-renowned musicians that can be found across the country's most prestigious orchestras; and
