#### AN ORDINANCE

Establishing parking regulations in the vicinity of: Green street and N. 11th street; N. 13th street and Mount Vernon street; Allen street and Germantown avenue; Wallace street and N. 12th street; Lawrence street and Poplar street; Brandywine street and N. 10th street; Berks street and Girard avenue.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. The following parking regulation is hereby established:

Two-Hour Parking 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM Monday -Friday Except RPP #10

Green street, both sides, N. 11th street to N. 12th street.

SECTION 2. The following parking regulation is hereby established:

Two-Hour Parking 8:00 AM – 6:30 PM Monday -Friday Except RPP #10

N. 13th street, both sides, Mount Vernon street to Wallace street.

SECTION 3. The following parking regulation is hereby established:

Two-Hour Parking 8:00 AM – 12:00 AM Monday -Sunday Except RPP #10

Allen street, north side, Germantown avenue to Hope street.

SECTION 4. The following parking regulation is hereby established:

Two-Hour Parking 8:00 AM – 6:30 PM Monday -Friday Except RPP #10/25

Berks street, both sides, Girard avenue to Wildey street.
