Congratulating the St. Huberts Cheerleading team for winning the 2021 PIAA Competitive Spirit State Championship.

WHEREAS, The St. Hubert High School cheerleading team, the Bambies, won the Pennsylvania State 2021 PIAA Competitive Spirit Championships on Saturday, April 10, 2021; and
