THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 16-400 of The Philadelphia Code is hereby amended to read as follows: CHAPTER 16-400. VACANT AND SURPLUS PROPERTIES

§16-404. The Vacant Property Review Committee.
