**WHEREAS**, Police Officer Walter Barclay was appointed to the Philadelphia Police Department on April 26, 1965; and

**WHEREAS**, Officer Barclay was assigned to the 35<sup>th</sup> Police District where he served as a Line Squad Patrol Officer; and

WHEREAS, On November 27, 1966 at 3:00 a.m., Police Officer Barclay and another officer responded to a burglary call at a hair salon located at 6604 North 5th Street. When they arrived, the officers confronted a man in the rear of the location, who shot Officer Barclay twice before fleeing; and

WHEREAS, Due to his wounds, Officer Barclay was left paralyzed from the waist down at age 23; and

**WHEREAS**, On August 19, 2007, Officer Barclay succumbed to complications from this gunshot wound which he received 40 years earlier; and

WHEREAS, Officer Barclay died at the age of 64; and

WHEREAS, Officer Barclay resided at 4036 Mitchell Street; and

**WHEREAS**, Officer Barclay is survived by his sister, Rosalyn Harrison, and his brother, William Barclay; and

**WHEREAS**, In recognition of the dedicated service by Police Officer Walter Barclay and to further memorialize the sacrifice he made by serving and protecting the citizens of Philadelphia; now therefore
