**WHEREAS**, Police Officer Charles Cassidy was appointed to the Philadelphia Police Department on March 1, 1982; and

**WHEREAS**, On December 24, 1996, Officer Cassidy was assigned to the 35<sup>th</sup> Police District where he served as a member of the 5 Squad; and

WHEREAS, On October 31, 2007, Officer Cassidy was checking on a store at the corner of 66th Avenue and Broad Street that had been robbed previously. Unknown to Officer Cassidy, there was a robbery in progress in the store. As Officer Cassidy entered, the suspect turned and fired, hitting Officer Cassidy in the head; and

**WHEREAS**, Officer Cassidy was transported to Albert Einstein Medical Center, where he remained until succumbing to the gunshot wound on November 1, 2007; and

**WHEREAS**, The suspect was arrested in Florida by members of the Miami Police Department on November 6, 2007 and presently awaits trial; and

**WHEREAS**, Officer Cassidy died at the age of 54, having served in the Philadelphia Police Department for 25 years; and

WHEREAS, Officer Cassidy resided at 2736 Willits Road; and

WHEREAS, Officer Cassidy is survived by his wife, Judith, his three children Katie, Nicole and John; and
