WHEREAS, The Marian Anderson Scholar Artist Program, partnered with the organization, hosts many events to showcase the talents of musical ambassadors as they represent Marian Anderson’s legacy of supporting artists and showcasing their talents around the world; and

WHEREAS, The exhibit for 2022 will focus on the role that Marian Anderson had in the civil rights movement in the 1960s and how she used her talents to deliver a powerful message; and

WHEREAS, By creating new exhibits every year, the National Marian Anderson Museum & Historical Society continue Anderson’s legacy and contributions to the musical world, and society through the different glimpses of Anderson’s life; now, therefore, be it
