Amending Section 9-213 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Farmers' Markets," by amending the permissible locations, all under certain terms and conditions.

*THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:*

SECTION 1. Section 9-213 of The Philadelphia Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 9-213. Farmers' Markets.

\* \* \*

(7) Permissible Locations. Farmers' Markets at the following locations shall be permitted:

\* \* \*

(n) The sidewalk and adjoining curb lane of the east side of South Broad Street between South Street and [Rodman] *Kater* Street.

\* \* \*

(z) The sidewalk of the median of the 400 block of South 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, also known as Headhouse Square[.], *and the north bound travel lane of South 2nd Street between Lombard Street and Pine Street.*

*(ww) The sidewalk and adjoining curb lane of the east side of North Third Street from Poplar Street to Wildey Street.*
