WHEREAS, Global Youth Service Day offers a way for local, national, and international organizations to BUILD the capacity of an international network of organizations that promotes youth participation, service, and learning; and

WHEREAS, Global Youth Service Day offers a way to EDUCATE the public, the media, and policy-makers about the year-round contributions of young people as community leaders around the world; and

WHEREAS, Global Youth Service Day offers a way to MOBILIZE youth and adults to meet the needs of their communities through volunteering; and

WHEREAS, Global Youth Service Day offers a way to LEARN and share effective practices in youth service,

WHEREAS, Through community service, young people build character and learn valuable skills, including time management, teamwork, needs-assessment, and leadership, that are sought by employers; and

WHEREAS, Service-learning combines meaningful service to the community with academic curriculum to benefit both participants and the communities they serve; and

WHEREAS, Young people should be viewed not only as the hope of the future, but as leaders and problemsolvers for today, and should be valued for the unique idealism, energy, creativity, and commitment they bring to the challenges found in their communities; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF PHILADELPHIA, That April 24th - 26th 2009 be declared as "Global Youth Service Day" in Philadelphia.
