Amending The Philadelphia Code by adding a new section prohibiting the parking or maintaining of semitrailers and truck tractors at residential properties, all under certain terms and conditions.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 12-1100 of The Philadelphia Code is hereby amended as follows:

CHAPTER 12-1100. MISCELLANEOUS REGULATIONS AND PENALTIES.

* * *

- §12-1135. Prohibited Parking or Maintaining of Semitrailers and Truck Tractors at Residential Properties.
- (1) Definitions. The terms Semitrailer and Truck Tractor have the meanings as defined in the Vehicle Code at 75 Pa. C.S. § 102.
 - (2) No person shall park or maintain a semitrailer or truck tractor on a driveway or other part of a property

utilized or zoned for residential purposes that is visible from a location outside of such property.
(3) Penalties. The penalty for a violation of this Section shall be a fine of \$500 for each offense for each day the violation continues.
SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately.
