WHEREAS, Rufus O. Williams, was a Philadelphia public school teacher and retired in 1985 from Sulzberger Junior High School in West Philadelphia; where he was on the faculty for thirty years; and

WHEREAS, Rufus O. Williams was employed by the Fairmount Park Commission for more than 30 years; and

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. The play area currently designated as the "Cobbs Creek Playground," located at 63rd and Catharine Streets is hereby named as the "Rufus O. Williams Memorial Playground."

SECTION 2. The Ordinance should take effect immediately.
