Authorizing the installation of all-way stop signs at the intersection of Fifty-first street and Overbrook avenue.

*THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:*

SECTION 1. All-way stop signs shall be placed and maintained at the following intersection in a manner consistent with PennDOT regulations:

(a) Fifty-first street and Overbrook avenue.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect 30 days after final passage.
