Honoring and Recognizing February, 2017 as Career and Technical Education (CTE) Awareness Month in the City of Philadelphia.

WHEREAS, More than 6,000 Philadelphia School District students attend a Career and Technical Education program at more than 30 high schools across the City; and

WHEREAS, These students earn valuable college credit and industry recognized credentials in these programs; and

WHEREAS, 81% of dropouts say relevant, real-world learning opportunities would have kept them in high school; and

WHEREAS, The average high school graduation rate for students concentrating in CTE is 90.18%, compared to a national average of 74.9%; and

WHEREAS, CTE students in the School District of Philadelphia earn over 3,400 industry credentials annually; and

WHEREAS, There will be more than 6,700 jobs opening in the trade, transportation, and utilities sector over the next five years in Philadelphia; and

WHEREAS, The School District of Philadelphia has planned more than a dozen events throughout the month of February to raise awareness around the opportunities within the Career and Technical Education programs they run; now, therefore, be it
