WHEREAS, In addition to workshops, Smith provides schools with coloring books, math workbooks, and Social-Emotional Learning workbooks, which hone students' math and problem solving skills who may need alternative educational needs; and

WHEREAS, BlitzChampz is licensed in every NFL team store and has decks available to represent every child or family's favorite team; now, therefore, be it
