WHEREAS, Children with autistic disorders do not have recreational activities designed for their benefit; and



THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHI HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Title 15 of The Philadelphia Code is hereby amended to read as follows:



§15-603. Programs in Recreational Facilities for Children with Autistic Disorders.

(1) The Recreation Department shall provide ten percent of all program activities and budgetary expenditures at one Class A recreational facility for the benefit of children with autistic disorders.

* * *

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall become effectively immediately.
