WHEREAS, Seamus is extremely active in organized labor circles in addition to his many responsibilities with the AOH. He was a member of the Metropolitan District Council of Carpenters for 47 years and held the position of Business Representative of Local 122 for 14 years; and

WHEREAS, March 14, 2010, marks the occasion of the 240<sup>th</sup> annual Saint Patrick's Day Parade in the City of Philadelphia. It is the hard work and devotion of the Saint Patrick's Observance Committee that keeps alive this historic parade.
