Amending Chapter 16-900 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Philadelphia Workforce Housing Opportunity Zones," by modifying the definitions; all under certain terms and conditions.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 16-900 of The Philadelphia Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER 16-900. PHILADELPHIA WORKFORCE HOUSING OPPORTUNITY ZONES.

§ 16-901. Definitions.

In this Chapter the following definitions shall apply: (1)

Affordable Workforce [Homeownership] Housing. Homeownership and Rental [H]h (a) ousing affordable to households whose income is between 80% and 120% of Area Median Income as established by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

§ 16-902. Designation of Zones.

(1) The areas of the City generally known as follows shall be designated as Philadelphia Affordable Workforce Housing Opportunity Zones:

> Reserved. (a)

§ 16-903. Authorization to Dispose of Publicly-Owned Property for Nominal Consideration.

(1)Publicly owned properties in designated Philadelphia Affordable Workforce Housing Opportunity Zones shall be available for disposition for nominal consideration for the development of Affordable Workforce [Homeownership] Housing as defined in § 16-901(a), upon approval by ordinance.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
