Amending Chapter 10-800 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Safety," by adding a new section entitled "Rooftop Conduct," by prohibiting certain conduct on roofs; all under certain terms and conditions.

*THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:*

SECTION 1. Title 10 of The Philadelphia Code is hereby amended as follows:

TITLE 10. REGULATION OF INDIVIDUAL CONDUCT AND ACTIVITY.

\* \* \*

CHAPTER 10-800 SAFETY

\* \* \*

§ 10-841. *Rooftop Conduct.*

(1) *Prohibited Conduct. No Person shall engage in the following on a roof, roof overhang or roof extension of a residential building, not designed and legally permitted for use as outdoor recreational space:*

- (a) *Fighting*
- (b) *Drinking alcoholic beverages*
- (c) *Running across the roofs of adjacent properties*
- (d) *Peering into skylights*
- (e) *Tanning*

(2) *Penalty. The penalty for violation of this Section shall be a fine of not more than \$300.00 and*

*imprisonment for not more than 90 days.*

*(3) Enforcement. Persons who are found in violation of this Section shall be issued a Notice of Violation by the police or other authorized law enforcement officer.*

*(4) The provisions of this Section shall only apply to the areas within the /NCP, North Central Philadelphia Overlay District as described in § 14-506 of this code.*

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately.
