SECTION 1. Title 19 of The Philadelphia Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

TITLE 19. FINANCE, TAXES AND COLLECTIONS.

CHAPTER 19-1300. REAL ESTATE TAXES

* * *

§19-1310. Tax Credit for Lead Paint and Other Hazards Remediation.

(1) Tax Credit. Any lessor who incurs the expense of remediation of lead paint and other hazards r equired under § 6-803 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Lead Disclosure Obligation," shall be entitled to a full credit for all such expenses against real estate taxes imposed under this Chapter for the property subjected to such remediation.
