SECTION 1. Section 2 of an Ordinance (Bill No. 180560) approved July 10, 2018, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

SECTION 2. This authorization is conditional upon compliance with the following requirements [within two (2) years from the date this Ordinance becomes law] by July 10, 2022:
