Amending Section 12-2705 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Issuance of Resident Parking Permits," to address the cost of resident parking permits for certain low-income individuals, all under certain terms and conditions.

*THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:*

SECTION 1. Title 12 of The Philadelphia Code is hereby amended as follows:

### TITLE 12. TRAFFIC CODE

CHAPTER 12-2700. PERMIT PARKING DISTRICTS

\* \* \*

§ 12-2705. Issuance of Resident Parking Permits.

\* \* \*

(7) *Notwithstanding the other provisions of this Section, low-income individuals that reside within permit parking District 38, shall not be required to pay an annual permit fee for the first vehicle in their household. Low-income individuals that reside within permit parking District 38 shall be required to submit a completed permit application and an annual permit fee of sixty dollars (\$60) for each additional vehicle in the household, beyond the first vehicle. In determining the number of vehicles in a household, the Department shall not count motorcycles or motor-driven cycles; and provided, further that the annual fee for each motorcycle or motor-driven cycle shall be thirty-five dollars (\$35).*

(a) *The Revenue Department shall promulgate regulations to determine the eligibility guidelines for low-income individuals for purposes of this subsection.*

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be effective 180 days after it becomes law.
