RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA, AS FOLLOWS

SECTION 1.

The Commissioner of Public Property is hereby authorized to transfer to the Philadelphia Redevelopment Authority fee simple title to 2147 N. 5th Street pursuant to Section 16-405 of the Philadelphia Code.

SECTION 2.

The Philadelphia Redevelopment Authority is hereby authorized to transfer to the Philadelphia Land Bank fee simple title to 2147 N. 5th Street pursuant to Section 16-405 of the Philadelphia Code.
