WHEREAS, Kevin Vaughan has not only had a successful public sector career, he is also a community leader and has served as Board Secretary and Trustee for Lincoln University, Board President of the Calcutta House, Family Planning Council, and International Network of Lesbian and Gay Officials, First Vice President for the International Assoc. of Official Human Rights Agencies, and Board Member of the St. Christopher's Foundation for Children and Mayor's Advisory Board for the City's Combined Campaign; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Vaughan has received numerous awards and accommodations including but not limited to the Internal Revenue Service Community Leadership Award, University of Pennsylvania Martin Luther King Award, International Network of Lesbian and Gay Officials Service Award, Commission on Human Relations - Award of Merit, Philadelphia Bar Association Civil Rights Champion, and U.S. Conference of Mayors City Livability Award; and

WHEREAS, in December 2013, after a 23.5 year engagement and waiting for state law to catch up, Kevin Vaughan married Charles Kaplan; now, therefore, be it
