WHEREAS, Philadelphia City Council is honored to join the growing list of places that have installed a POW/MIA Empty Chair as a constant reminder of those that have gone missing and those that never came home; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA, That we authorize the placing of "One Empty Seat" the POW/MIA National Chair of Honor in Philadelphia City Hall as a solemn reminder of all of those that serve.
