Amending Chapter 9-200 of The Philadelphia Code (entitled “Commercial Activities on Streets”) by amending Section 9-213, entitled “Farmers’ Markets,” to revise certain provisions relating to the permissible location of the farmers’ market on south 43rd street near Clarke Park; all under certain terms and conditions.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 9-200 of The Philadelphia Code is amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER 9-200 COMMERCIAL ACTIVITIES ON STREETS.

* * *

§ 9-213 Farmers’ Markets.

* * *

(7) Permissible Locations. Farmers’ markets at the following locations shall be permitted:

* * *

(r) The sidewalk and the curb lane of the west side of the 500 block of South 43rd Street *on Thursdays. The 500 block of South 43rd Street, between Baltimore Avenue and Chester Avenue, excluding the sidewalks, shall be permitted for use on Saturdays only, year round, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.*
