Authorizing the overnight truck parking for the commercial vehicle of Vincent Cappello, owner and operator of Vinny's Fruit and Produce, located in the right-of-way on the north side of Dickinson Street between 9th and 10th Street, and excepting Mr. Cappello from certain provisions of Section 9-203 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Street Vendors," and certain provisions of Section 12-901 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Stopping, Standing or Parking Prohibited at Certain Places," all under certain terms and conditions.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Permission is hereby granted to Vincent Cappello, owner and operator of Vinny's Fruit and Produce, to permit overnight truck parking of his commercial vehicle located in the right-of-way on the north side of Dickinson Street between 9th and 10th Street, thus excepting the commercial vehicle of Vincent Cappello from Section 9-203(7)(k) and Section 12-901(3) of The Philadelphia Code, which prohibit the overnight truck parking of conveyances and commercial vehicles.

SECTION 2. Before exercising any rights or privileges under this Ordinance, Vincent Cappello must first obtain all required permits, licenses and approvals from all appropriate departments, boards, agencies or commissions. No such department, board, agency or commission shall be required to issue any such permit, license or approval solely because this Ordinance has been enacted, it being the express intent of this Ordinance not to supersede any other provision of law governing the issuance of such permits, licenses or approvals.

SECTION 3. The permission granted to Vincent Cappello described in Section 1 shall expire without any further action by the City of Philadelphia if Vincent Cappello has not satisfied all requirements that are listed in Section 2 of this Ordinance within one (1) year after this Ordinance becomes law. The permission granted to Vincent Cappello described in Section 1 is not transferrable.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
