Welcoming President Joseph R. Biden and the House Democratic Caucus to Philadelphia on March 9, 2022 to March 11, 2022 for the annual House Democratic Caucus Issues Conference.

WHEREAS, The House Democratic Caucus is comprised of all Democratic Representatives within the United States House of Representatives; and

WHEREAS, The House Democratic Caucus is responsible for nominating and electing Democratic Party leaderships and for the development of party policy and legislative priorities.

The House Democratic Caucus is currently led by Caucus Chairman Hakeem Jeffries and Vice Chairman Pete Aguilar; and
