WHEREAS, Born and raised in Southwest Philadelphia, Dr. Proctor is a proud graduate of Temple University and the University of Pennsylvania and has dedicated his life to uplifting others through education and service; and

WHEREAS, As Founder and CEO of Wesley Proctor Ministries, Inc., he has awarded more than \$50,000 in book scholarships to Philadelphia high school seniors, supporting their transition to higher education; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Proctor has spent over two decades teaching nonprofit management and helping more than 1,000 organizations obtain 501(c)(3) status, strengthening community impact; and

WHEREAS, Through more than 20 years of service as Youth Pastor and Executive Administrator at Victory Christian Center Church, he has mentored and empowered young people across Philadelphia; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Proctor’s contributions have been recognized with numerous honors, including the 2024 Presidential Lifetime Achievement Award; and
